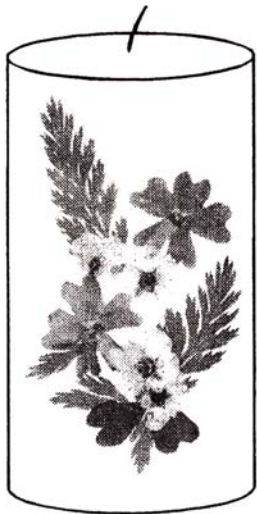


# Pressed Flower Candle

## Materials Needed

- "Pressed Flowers" Package by *Nature's Pressed*
- Pillar Candle (any size)
- Tweezers (flat, round tip is best)
- Sm. Craft paintbrush (for gluing flowers)
- White Craft glue
- "Mod-Podge" Sealer
- 1" Paintbrush



## Easy 5-Step Instructions

1. Remove flowers from package with tweezers. Store unused flowers in package for later use.
2. Dilute craft glue with a small amount of water to make a smooth consistency without being watery. Apply dots of glue to backs of flowers with paintbrush. Use tweezers to hold flowers and place on candle.
3. Brush glue under edges of flowers so that the flowers are as flat as possible. Allow to dry.
4. Apply "Mod Podge" sealer over the entire candle with 1" paintbrush using long smooth strokes, starting from the center of arrangement, working towards edges. Allow to dry. A second coat may be applied for a glossier finish.
5. Keep the candle away from direct sunlight. This will allow the flowers to retain their color as long as nature allows. (Candle is for decorative purposes only. Do not burn.)
