



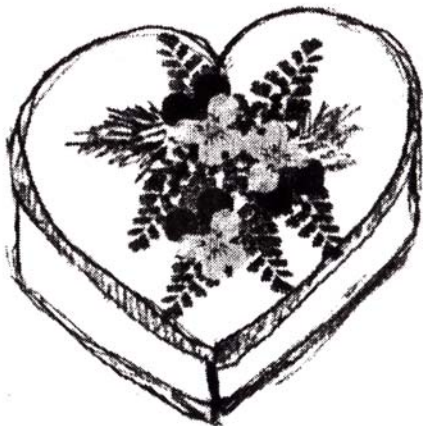
Pressed Flower Valentine Keepsake Box

Materials Needed

- * "Pressed Flowers" package by Nature's Pressed with flowers of your choice
- * Paper mache', cardboard, or wooden trinket box in shape of your choice (heart would be perfect!)
- * Paint in color of your choice
- * Paintbrush for paint
- * Craft glue
- * Tweezers (round, flat tip is best)
- * Small craft paintbrush for glue
- * Clear sealing spray or Decoupage Sealer

Easy 5 Step Instructions

1. Paint entire box, including inside of lid and bottom. Allow to dry.
2. Remove flowers from package with tweezers. Store leftovers in container for later use.
3. Using tweezers to hold the flowers, apply small dots of glue to the backs of the flowers and apply to the painted box. You may place the flowers on the top, outside sides, inside sides, inside lid, inside bottom, and outside bottom. Be creative!
4. Use small craft paintbrush to apply glue underneath all edges of flowers to secure. Gently blow a bit of air onto the flowers to see which parts may still be loose. Glue securely. Allow to dry.
5. Spray entire box with sealing spray. Remember the inside of lid and bottom. Or, you may brush on a decoupage' type sealer such as Mod Podge, but use sparingly, as it may make the flowers wrinkle and fade Enjoy!
